The 2018 ADAMI Media Prize 1st Deadline has Passed

ADAMI announces that 1 July 2018 was the first deadline for submitting competition documents. This deadline applied to submissions broadcasted or published between 10 October 2016 to 1 January 2018.

For videos and web-pages created and published after 1 January 2018, the competition remains open. ADAMI encourages journalists, filmmakers and audio-visual professionals to take a chance and apply to the next deadline.

The final deadline for ADAMI 2018 is 1 October 2018.

The competition is open to broadcasters, production companies, independent journalists, filmmakers, producers and other media professionals in the six EU Eastern Partnership countries: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, and Ukraine. The prize rewards outstanding TV, film, and online programmes which deal with topics of migration,

integration, and ethnic, religious, and cultural diversity. This is a unique opportunity for media professionals to showcase their audio-visual work and to connect with a network of broadcasters. Participants are eligible to win cash prizes that are awarded to winners in each category. Besides, every ADAMI Media Prize 2018 competition participant with journalism experience and working ability in Russian, German or French will be eligible to apply for an ADAMI fellowship at Deutsche Welle (Berlin, Germany), MDR (Leipzig, Germany) and Arte (Strasbourg, France).

The ADAMI Media Prize is awarded in six [categories](#):

- ADAMI Media Prize for Entertainment (fiction)
- ADAMI Media Prize for Information (non-fiction)
- ADAMI Media Prize for News & Short Non-Fiction
- Young ADAMI Media Prize
- ADAMI Online Prize for Web pages
- ADAMI Online Prize for Web videos

An international jury of media professionals and experts will convene in October 2018 in Odessa (Ukraine) to select the nominees and winners. Winners will be announced in November 2018 at a gala award ceremony held in Chisinau, Moldova, which will be broadcast internationally.

The ADAMI Media Prize is financed by the Federal Foreign Office (Federal Republic of Germany) and ProCredit Holding.
