### **ADAMI Studio – Editing Workshop in Chisinau**

The ADAMI Media Prize for Cultural Diversity in Eastern Europe has organized workshops for fiction and documentary films in the editing stage, that address issues related to cultural diversity, tolerance, integration, or peaceful coexistence. The first such workshop has been taken place between May 26-28, 2019, in Chisinau, Moldova and is carried out in partnership with the International Documentary Film Festival "Cronograph".

At the workshop, the film teams had the chance to discuss their projects and work with international film and editing experts. Acclaimed filmmaker Irene Langemann (Germany), director/editor Radu Dumitru (Moldova) and film editor/war correspondent Mikhail Moskalenko (Ukraine) counseled the participants on their projects. The purpose of the workshop was to interact and share experiences among the participants, as well as to introduce different approaches to the subject's rendering process, thus enhancing the attractiveness of such films for the widest international audience. The workshop took place in different editing rooms, then they exchanged their works and edited the films of the other participants.

Apart from the activity in the editing rooms, the participants in ADAMI Studio had the chance to take part in the screenings and networking events the festival offered to its international guests.

The workshop was attended by Moldovan production studios, TV stations or TV producers, as well as individual producers.

**About the ADAMI Media Prize for Cultural Diversity in Eastern Europe:** The ADAMI Media Prize was created to encourage filmmakers, journalists and audio-visual media professionals in the EU Eastern Partnership countries to promote topics of migration, tolerance, and cultural diversity. The prize rewards outstanding TV, film and online projects, that deal with diversity-related issues.
